8	OTHER PURPOSES.		
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10	WHEREAS, the Parks & Recreation Department requests a construction contract for the installation		
11	of a Gametime Superior Recreational Products Pavilion and a Gametime Powerscape Modular Playground		
12	Structure with accessible poured-in rubber surfacing; and,		
13	WHEREAS, An Outdoor Legacy Grant was received in an amount of Six Hundred Twenty-One		
14	Thousand, Six Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$621,614.00) with a required City match of Seven Hundred		
15	Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) for a total project budget of 1.4 million for Western Hills Park; and,		
16	WHEREAS, the Gametime Pavilion and playground structure project will not exceed a cost of Five		
17	Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$515,000.00) which is a base project cost of Four Hundred Forty-Seven		
18	Thousand, Nine Hundred Eleven and 03/100 (\$447,911.03) with contingency funding; and,		
19	WHEREAS, funding for the contract with Gametime will be provided by the Western Hills Park 3/8-		
20	Cent Capital Improvement Sales Tax Funds, Account No. 326459-TS45A20, and the Legacy Grant Funds		
21	Account No. 270459-G23147; and,		
22	WHEREAS, the project for the new pavilion and playground was quoted using OMNIA Partners		
23	Public Sector Program, No. 2017001134.		
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
25	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
26	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a construction agreement with Gametime for		
27	the installation of a Gametime Superior Recreational Products Pavilion and a Gametime Powerscape		
28	Modular Playground Structure with accessible poured-in place rubber surfacing at Western Hills Park.		
29	Section 2. Funding will be provided by the Western Hills Park 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales		
30	Tax Funds, Account No. 326459-TS45A20, and the Legacy Grant Funds, Account No. 270459-G23147.		
31	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
32	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
33	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		

1	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of th		
2	resolution.		
3	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent wit		
4	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. ADOPTED: September 1, 2020
