12	WHEREAS, it is necessary to place laptop computers into each of these vehicles for use by the Little
13	Rock Police Department; and,
14	WHEREAS, the City is able to purchase these laptop computers from Dell Computer Sales pursuant
15	to Arkansas State Contract No.SP-16-0019, in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand,
16	Seventy-One and 40/100 Dollars (\$189,071.40);
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
18	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
19	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to purchase sixty (60) Dell laptop computers from Dell
20	Computer Sales, in the amount of One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand, Seventy-One and 40/100 Dollars
21	(\$189,071.40), for use by the Little Rock Police Department.
22	Section 2. Funds for this appropriation are available in Account No. 325529-72300-F447002 as part
23	of the 2017 Police Short Term Note.
24	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
25	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
26	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
27	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
28	resolution.
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
30	with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
