7	for the period of January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2023, for Voluntary Group Universal Life Insurance fo

9	Section 2. Funding for the voluntary benefits for City of Little Rock employees is solely at the expense
20	of the employee.
21	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, o
22	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration o
23	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
24	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
.5	resolution.
6	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
7	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
