14	CAT; and,		
15	WHEREAS, the total cost for the purchase of one (1) Trail King Trailer is Seventy-Three Thousand,		
16	Three Hundred Thirty-Seven and 37/100 Dollars (\$73,737.37).		
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY

20	not to exceed Seventy-Three Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Seven and 37/100 Dollars (\$73,737.37), fo		
21	the purchase of one (1) Trail King Trailer, Model No. TK50RB, to be utilized by the Parks & Recreation		
22	Department.		
23	Section 2. Funds for this agreement are available to be paid from two (2) accounts: Fleet Account		
24	No. 210759-72300-S00B399, in the amount of Thirty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$33,000.00); and Parks &		
25	Recreation Account No. 104523-63211, in the amount of Forty Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven		
26	and 37/100 Dollars (\$40,737.37).		
27	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
28	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
29	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and		
30	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the		
31	resolution.		
32	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
33	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
