Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained from the office of the Engineer, Department of Public Works, at the above address, at a cost of \$50.00 for each set, check or money order (no cash) payable to the City of Little Rock. NO REFUNDS will be made.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value), or satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total of bid shall be submitted with each bid.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the contract documents must be paid on the project, and that the contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

Each bidder must be in compliance with the requirements of Act 150 of 1965, effective June 9, 1965, subject to any subsequent amendments, which is the current Arkansas State Licensing Law for Contractors

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informalities in bidding. Bids may be held by the City for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders prior to awarding of the contract.

**NOTICE**

**The City of Little Rock selects its board and commission members through a process that utilizes an executive session. Under Arkansas law, this fact deems a volunteer an employee for a limited purpose. The City cannot contract with an employee, and cannot contract with a corporation with an employee in an executive or managerial position who also serves as a volunteer on a City board or commission unless it first passes an ordinance to approve the contract. In the Statement of Bidder's Qualifications, Bidders are asked if any person involved with this Bid is an employee of the City, or a volunteer board or commission member who also holds an executive or managerial position with the Bidder. If the answer is "yes," Bidders are asked to please identify the person(s) and the nature of the relationship. THIS DOES NOT MEAN that the Bidder is disqualified; but, the apparent successful Bidder will not be selected if the Board of Directors fails to pass an ordinance to authorize the contract, regardless of the amount.**
