Amount for construction services is Three Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand, One Hundred Sixty-Eight and 32/100 Dollars (\$322,168.32), Two Hundred Sixty-Eight, Four Hundred Seventy-Three and 60/100 Dollars (\$268,473.60) plus 20% contingencies;

Section 2. Funding for this project is available from the 2012 ¾-Cent Capital Sales Tax Project Funds.

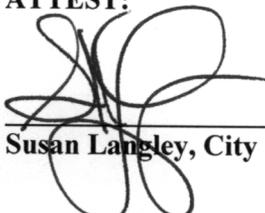

Section 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.

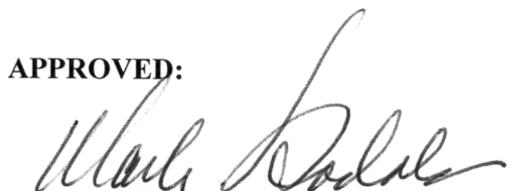

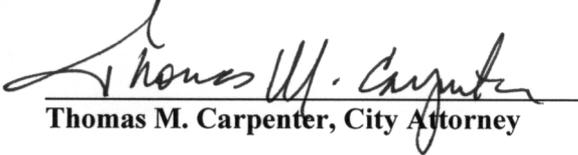
