RESOLUTION NO. 13,959

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GENE SUMMERS CONSTRUCTION, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$353,382.72, FOR THE SHELIA LANE AND MEYER ROAD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Bids were solicited for Project No. 13-7-080, Shelia Lane and Meyer Road Drainage Improvements, Bid No. 14-147; and,

WHEREAS Gene Summers Construction, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for Gene Summers Construction, Inc., for the Shelia Lane and Meyer Road Drainage Improvement project. Amount for construction services is Three Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Two and 72/100 Dollars (\$353,382.72); Two Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand, Four Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand and 60/100 Dollars (\$294,485.60), base bid plus 20% contingencies.

Section 2. Funding for this project is available from the 2012-Cent Capital Sales Tax Project Funds.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This resolution will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.




