



Back of License




Two dimensional (2D) bar code includes all of the information from the front of the document except the photo and signature.

Arkansas Driver License & ID Cards

The State of Arkansas Office of Driver Services will begin issuing new Drivers Licenses and Identification Cards in the spring of 2011.

The new look provides a number of redesigned features which make altering, tampering or counterfeiting these documents extremely difficult.

Printed onto a highly durable plastic card are every cardholder's personal information, photo with 'ghosted' image, and two signatures. A security laminate covers each card. This feature not only increases the durability of the card, it also makes it more tamper resistant. The variable background colors and patterns help make the cards difficult to counterfeit.

The orientation for all cardholders under the age of 21 will be vertical instead of horizontal. This features makes the card immediately recognizable as an under age document. Every card shows the date the individual turns 18 or 21.

The color of the map in the upper right corner of each document helps to quickly identify the type of document: green for Drivers Licenses, blue for Commercial Drivers Licenses (CDL), red for ID cards, yellow for Intermediate Drivers Licenses, and white for Learners Permits.
