What is The First Tee?

The First Tee of Central Arkansas is a youth development program and 150+ acre public golf facility which focuses on introducing young people aged 3-17 to positive values through the game of golf. The First Tee Life Skills Experience, a proven curriculum for teaching character education through specific life skills while learning how to play golf, is one of the unique features that differentiates The First Tee from other youth initiatives. Ultimately, we instill in participants The First Tee Nine Core Values—honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, respect, confidence, responsibility, perseverance, courtesy, and judgment.

The First Tee Life Skills Experience is delivered by trained volunteer and staff coaches who work with our youth members in small-group settings at our facility. These classes take place year round during the week and on Saturday. We at The First Tee invite you to also enroll your child as one of our Members. Membership to The First Tee, starting at \$175/year, will give your child(ren) access to The First Tee's world class golf facility, free golf equipment, and group lessons through The First Tee Life Skills Experience.

How Do I Get My Child Involved?

Signing your child up to be a Member of The First Tee is easy. Bring your child to one of our weekly Parent-Child Orientation meetings at The First Tee—held every Saturday at 9:00 a.m.—any time this year. Immediately after the orientation, you will be given the opportunity to sign up your child.
