28th Annual Fishing Derby Attracted Nearly 900 Kids

The City of Little Rock hosted its 28th Annual Fishing Derby on Thursday, July 18 at MacArthur Park.

The Derby, which is also sponsored by the Arkansas Game & Fish Commission, was open to children ages 6-15 and attracted nearly 900 children from Central Arkansas.

The pond at MacArthur Park was stocked with more than 1,000 catfish by AGFC. Among those fish were a limited number of specially-tagged prize fish. Children who caught one of these prize fish were allowed to choose from a selection of prizes provided by Little Rock Parks & Recreation and the AGFC.

Logan Berry, a seven-year old girl from Little Rock, and Leo Moriarty, a seven-year old boy from Little Rock, were the first to catch a prize fish and each won a brand new bicycle.
