



Little Rock Parks & Recreation Receives \$40,000 Grant For Rock Creek Trail Extension

The Arkansas State Highway Commission has awarded Little Rock Parks & Recreation a \$40,000 grant for a planned extension of the Rock Creek Trail.

“This grant will allow us to extend our already extensive trail system for the citizens of Little Rock,” explained Little Rock Parks & Recreation Director, Truman Tolefree. “With nearly 80 miles of trails around the city, we are providing a very popular avenue for the people of Little Rock to get out and enjoy nature and exercise.”

Currently, Rock Creek Trail is 1.14-mile long and begins at the Bowman Curve Shopping Center and heads west.

The planned extension would add approximately 1,500 feet of asphalt trail through the Rock Creek area which is the wooded area in between the divided lanes of Chenal Parkway.

Future plans call for extending the Rock Creek Trail all the way to Wildwood, and possibly beyond.
