The Police Youth Live-In Camp is a summer camp for boys and girls ages 10-12 sponsored by the City of Little Rock Police Department.

The "Live-In" staff consists of police officers and camp counselors. Youngsters will be assigned to a room with other campers and two police officers with whom they will live during the five days and four nights of group activities.



Family style meals are served in the dining hall. Snacks and beverages are available a number of times throughout the day. Water is always available.

A completed application and recommendation form are required.

Applications may be obtained from your school counselor. Deadline for submission of applications is April 15, 2015

The Police Youth Live-In Camp enables pre-teens ages 10-12 to have direct and positive exposure to police officers through a five-day, four-night camp experience. The camp helps open lines of communication and improves relations between the officers and young people. Everyone participates in a variety of activities including:

- Swimming and boating
- Sports activities such as volleyball, softball
- Group games, camp sing-a-longs, campfires
- Nature explorations, arts and crafts, and a group service project
- Small group discussions on self-esteem, school, friends, prejudices, conflict resolution, alternatives to violence
- Field trips to important sites
- Demonstration by special police units such as Canine and Mounted Patrols
- Discussions and role plays about police work and law enforcement.
