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42 **Section 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to direct the Housing and Neighborhood Programs  
43 Department to raze and remove the structures condemned in this ordinance and to file and enforce a lien  
44 against the properties described herein for the cost of razing and removing said structures pursuant to  
45 Little Rock, Ark., Rev. Code (“LRC”) §20-29 (1988).

46 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, subparagraph,  
47 item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or

1 unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining provisions of this  
2 ordinance, as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision was not originally a part of this ordinance.

3 **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this  
4 ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

5 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** Unless the provisions of this ordinance are put into effect  
6 immediately, the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Little Rock will be adversely affected;  
7 therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
8 from and after its passage.
