A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH
BURKHALTER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND, TWO
HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT AND 80/100 DOLLARS, (\$518,248.80),
FOR THE JOHN BARROW ROAD STREETSCAPE
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design streetscape and intersection improvements on John Barrow Road at the Kanis Road Intersection; and,

WHEREAS, project improvements include reconstruction of sidewalks with associated driveway aprons, reconstruction of crosswalks and access ramps and installation of pedestrian crossing signals and related work; and,

WHEREAS, responses to an Invitation to Bid (“ITB”), Bid No. 3052 for John Barrow Streetscape were received by the City of Little Rock on November 25, 2025, and, of the (2) bids received, it was determined that Burkhalter Technologies, Inc, provided the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the John Barrow Streetscape project with Burkhalter Technologies, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Eighteen Thousand, Two Hundred Forty Eight and 80/100 Dollars, (\$518,248.80), which is the base bid amount of Four Hundred Thirty One Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy Four and 00/100 Dollars, (\$431,874.00) plus a Twenty percent (20%) contingency only if necessary to use it.

Section 2. Funding for this project is from the $\frac{3}{8}$ Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds, and the 2018 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution 14803. Account Activity TS6B137.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

1 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are
2 inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such
3 inconsistency.
