



1 which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitu-  
2 tional were not originally a part of this ordinance.

3 **Section 6. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the  
4 extent of such inconsistency.

5 **Section 7. Emergency Clause.** *The ability of older youth to obtain meaningful employment, and to have*  
6 *the necessary skills to gain such employment despite the fact the youth has dropped out of high school and*  
7 *is the age range of 18-24, is essential to the public health safety and welfare; the fact that the Little Rock*  
8 *School District offers a program that can be enhanced to include more City youth to obtain these skills is*  
9 *unique, but more to the point, the programs are now starting; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist*  
10 *and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
