<p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Resolution No. 15,524, as adopted by the Little Rock Board of Directors made a \$3,000,000.00 allotment of Local Fiscal Recovery Act Funds for Water and Sewer Infrastructure Improvement Projects. Staff has identified currently designed, eligible projects in Wards 1, 3 and 7. Hanson and McLaughlin, Inc., was selected for services through a Statement of Qualifications Process to design two (2) of the five (5) drainage projects that are to be constructed in Wards 1, 3 and 7.</p>
