<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to increase the authorized contract amount with FTN Associates, Ltd., for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for the Yorkwood Neighborhood Drainage Improvement Project on Smith Creek.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>This amendment authorizes an increase to the existing contract ceiling price of \$68,000.00, for an amended contract price not to exceed amount of \$254,100.00. Funding for the project is from the American Rescue Plan Act allocation pursuant to Resolution No. 15,524 of August 17, 2021.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>Resolution No. 15,524, as adopted by the Little Rock Board of Directors made a \$3,000,000.00 allotment of Local Fiscal Recovery Act Funds for Water and Sewer Infrastructure Improvement Projects. Staff has identified currently designed, eligible projects in Wards 1, 3 and 7. FTN Associates, Ltd., was previously selected to complete preliminary design work for the project and will now be authorized to complete the design and prepare the application for the required U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit(s).</p>
