

1 (b) The windows to be restored in accordance with the guidelines of the U.S. Secretary of the
2 Interior are those located on the first and second floor; and,

3 (c) The original third floor windows shall be maintained in a safe and dry place at the Women’s
4 City Club; and,

5 (d) A manufacturer’s specification sheet on the replacement windows is attached as Exhibit B to
6 this resolution.

7 **Section 2.** To the extent that such actions constitutes an amendment of Little Rock, Ark., Resolution
8 No. 11,369 (September 3, 2002), and the attached exhibit, such an amendment is authorized.

9 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase,
10 or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
11 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force
12 and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part
13 of the resolution.

14 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
15 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not
16 limited to Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 11,369 (September 3, 2002), and its exhibit.
