BACKGROUND	<p>Ark. Code Ann. §14-58-101 (West Supp. 2015) sets minimum standards for annual audits. The Statute further provides that the governing body of a municipality may choose to adopt audit standards that exceed the minimum standard.</p> <p>For some time now, Little Rock has caused its annual audit to be performed in accordance with the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, and the United States Government Accountability Office Guidelines and Formats. This resolution affirms the Board's commitment to the highest standards of financial reporting for the 2025 Audit.</p>
