SYNOPSIS	Authorizes the City Manager to execute a supplement to the Agreement of Understanding with ARDOT for Job 061510 to increase the amount of the City's contribution to allow for the award of the construction contract.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The amount of the requested increase is \$716,093.85 for a not-to-exceed contribution of \$1,868,473.85, which is the post-bid City of Little Rock Share in the amount of \$1,557,061.54 plus a twenty percent (20%) contingency. Funding for this project is from the 3/8 Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax funds and the 2018 Capital Improvement Bonds, as authorized by Resolution 14803. Account Activity TS0B129.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	Resolution 14,458 (December 6, 2016) authorized the City to enter into an AOU with ARDOT for the implementation of Job 061510, Highway 70/ Highway 5 / University Avenue Intersection Improvements. The initial contribution of \$600,000.00 was subsequently increased pursuant to Resolution 16,674 (August 5, 2025) to \$1,152,380 to include the replacement of lightning-damaged equipment. ARDOT received two (2) competitive bids for construction of the project and is asking the City to increase its contribution to cover the as-bid cost of the lightning-damaged equipment replacement, related construction engineering, and 50% of the cost of the contract items included in the original	

agreement.
