20	Dollars (\$2,854,306.00), including applicable taxes and fees to renew maintenance and support services for	
21	the PremierOne Computer-Aided Dispatch and Mobile Software System.	
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY	
23	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS;	
24	Section 1. The Board of Directors finds that it is impractical and unfeasible to submit this contract to	
25	a competitive bid process.	
26	Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an amendment of the sole-source agreement	
27	with Motorola Solutions, Inc., in the amount of Two Million, Eight Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Three	
28	Hundred Six Dollars (\$2,854,306.00), including applicable taxes and fees to extend maintenance and	
29	support services for the PremierOne Computer-Aided Dispatch and Mobile Software System for one (1)	
30	five (5) year term.	
31	Section 3. Funding for this expenditure is available in the 911 Wireless Fund Account No. 220512.	
32	Section 4. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or	
33	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or	

adjudication shall not affect the remaining po	ortions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and			
effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution. Section 5. <i>Repealer</i> . All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
