22	14-58-101 (West Supp. 2015); and, the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, Financial Reporting Guidelines.		
23	Section 2. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word		
24	of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication		
25	shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the		
26	portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.		
27	Section 3. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, or parts of the same that are inconsistent		
28	with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
