WHEREAS, the City provides certain elective insurance benefit options for its employees and their dependents; and,

WHEREAS, Medical Transport coverage is an elective benefit the City offers to City employees and the associated expense is the employee's full responsibility and is in no way subsidized by the City.

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Medical Transport Services doing business as MASA for the period of January 1, 2026, to December 31, 2026, to provide elective Medical Transport coverage for City employees and their dependents.

Section 3. *Severability.* In the event any portion of this Resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of this Resolution.
