



1       **Section 3.** Funds for this service are available in the Little Rock Information Technology Department's  
2 Annual Operating Budget.

3       **Section 4. Severability.** In the event any portion of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid  
4 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this  
5 ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or  
6 unconstitutional were not originally a part of this ordinance.

7       **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any  
8 provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

9       **Section 6. Emergency Clause.** *As has been demonstrated in the annual City financial audit, the need*  
10 *for certain security training is mandated for a municipality that participates in certain programs and*  
11 *accepts certain funds, and that such training is critical to the public health, safety, and welfare; an*  
12 *emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after*  
13 *the date of its passage.*
