

BACKGROUND

The Hazard Mitigation Plan Funds were utilized to pay 75% of the hazard mitigation planning consultant service costs. The remaining 25% of consultant service costs were paid by Pulaski County, the City of Little Rock, and the City of North Little Rock.

The Hazard Mitigation Plan was developed over a period of thirty-six (36) months and included three (3) 3 meetings seeking public input in the planning process.
