<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CITIZEN PARTICIPATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>The resolution amends Resolution No. 13,957 to correct the total contract amount for a Web-Based Training component which will increase the Little Rock Fire Department's ability to deliver more in-service training opportunities for the men and women who carry out the Department's mission.</p> <p>The revised total cost is \$179,181.85 to be paid over a sixty (60)-month time frame, funded from the existing General Fund Budget and Act 833 Funds:</p> <p>Approval of the resolution</p> <p>N/A</p> <p>The Little Rock Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 13,957 on September 2, 2014, to authorize a contract with Target Solutions for a Web-Based Training component to provide in-service training across multiple disciplines within the Little Rock Fire Department. However, due to a calculation error in the vendor's proposed payment schedule, the total contract price was identified in Resolution No. 13,957 as \$153,429.96, but should have been \$179,181.85.</p>
