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**WHEREAS**, the existing Play Net at Murray Park Playground is at the end of its lifecycle and thus there is a need for the playground component to be replaced; and,

**WHEREAS**, the total cost of this purchase is in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Fifty-Three and 31/100 Dollars (\$122,053.31), including applicable taxes and fees.

**Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Landscape Structures, Inc., in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Fifty-Three and 31/100 Dollars (\$122,053.31), including applicable taxes and fees, to replace the Murray Park Playground Play Net and associated components.

**Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.
