14	vendor selection of Landscape Structures, Inc., was made utilizing Sourcewell cooperative purchasing

16	WHEREAS, the total cost of this purchase is in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-two		
17	Thousand Fifty-Three and 31/100 Dollars (\$122,053.31), including applicable taxes and fees.		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
19	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
20	Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Landscape Structures, Inc., in		
21	an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-two Thousand Fifty-Three and 31/100 Dollars		
22	(\$122,053.31), including applicable taxes and fees, to replace the Murray Park Playground Play Net and		
23	associated components.		
24	Section 2. Funding is available from Park Bond Funds Account No. 332459-B45D018.		
25	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this		
26	resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall		
27	not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion		
28	so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.		
29	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, which are inconsistent with		
30	the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
