

1 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
2 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
3 ordinance.

4 **Section 5. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws, and other matters inconsistent with this
5 ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

6 **Section 6. Emergency.** *The City's ability to properly maintain its budgets and to account for its funds*
7 *is essential to maintain the public health, safety and welfare; an emergency is, therefore, declared to exist*
8 *and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
