SYNOPSIS	To authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute	
FISCAL IMPACT	a construction contract for the procurement and transport of sheet pilings materials, demolition, removal and replacement of the Clinton Presidential Park Bridge Protection Cell. Funding for this project is from Account 325409-F40C634 with funds available from short-term financing as approved in Little Rock, Ark. Ordinance 22,645. The not-to-exceed authorization for construction is an amount not to exceed \$5,725,000.	
RECOMMENDATION	Pass the ordinance.	
BACKGROUND	In September 2021, a runaway barge hit the Interstate 30 Bridge and the pier protection cell beneath the Clinton Presidential Park Bridge causing substantial damage. The existing protection cell needs to be demolished, and a new protection cell built in its place. Massman Construction Company is uniquely qualified to procure and transport the necessary materials and perform the demolition and construction of the replacement cell, having the bargemounted equipment on hand and having recently completed construction of a nearly identical cell at the I-30 bridge just upstream.
