BACKGROUND

The Board of Directors of the City of Little Rock, Arkansas, passed Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance 21, 761 (July 23, 2019) allowing TEDs. A TED at Breckenridge was subsequently created. Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 16, 476 (October 15, 2024), ("LRR 16, 476"). The TED was extended. LRR 16, 572 (January 21, 2025). Events at Breckenridge Village, located at 10301 N. Rodney Parham Road, were of the idea that it could become a local restaurant hub that would not only attract people from Little Rock to visit, but also from neighboring cities and eventually neighboring states. The TED allows Breckenridge Village customers to walk and enjoy the diversity of the businesses in The District. The District restaurant owners have observed families talking, enjoying an outside atmosphere and moving from restaurant to restaurant with ease and enthusiasm. The synergy has been positive and has created a sense of community within the District and the greater Little Rock area. The extension of the TED will operate from December 31, 2025, through April 30, 2026, and will operate seven (7) days a week, from 11:00am to 10:00pm.
