15	15, T-1-N, R-12-W, CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, PULASKI COUNTY,		
16	ARKANSAS, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING 270 FEET NORTH		
17	AND 181.5 FEET EAST OF THE SW CORNER OF SAID NW1/4 SW1/4		
18	NE1/4 ; THENCE EAST 198.5 FEET; THENCE NORTH 64.5 FEET;		
19	THENCE WEST 198.5 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 64.5 FEET TO THE POINT		
20	OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 0.29 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.		
21	Section 2. That the preliminary site development plan/plat be approved as recommended by		
22	the Little Rock Planning Commission.		
23	Section 3. That the change in zoning classification contemplated for A & S Rental Propertie		
24	- STR-2 - PD-C, located at 2910 Broadway Street (Z-10189) is conditioned upon obtaining final plan		
25	approval within the time specified by Chapter 36, Article VII, Section 36-454 (e) of the Code of Ordinances.		
26	Section 4. That the map referred to in Chapter 36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City o		
27	Little Rock, Arkansas, and designated district map be and is hereby amended to the extent and in the respects		
28	necessary to affect and designate the change provided for in Section 1 hereof.

30	Section 5. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph item. sentence, clause		
31	phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration
