The premium for this policy is not to exceed \$121,602.00. This amount represents a flat renewal premium. It is the Broker's and Staff's recommendation to bind the quote from Crum & Forster not to exceed \$121,602.00 for the term of December 10, 2024, to December 10, 2025.
