16	Hundred Four Dollars (\$143,904.00), which includes a 20% contingency.		
17	WHEREAS, funding for the project is from Infrastructure as Economic Development Accounting

19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY		
20	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:		
21	Section 1. The Board of Directors authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Larry		
22	Harris dba Harris Construction Management, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Forty-Three		
23	Thousand, Nine Hundred Four Dollars (\$143,904.00), which includes a 20% contingency, for the 24th and		
24	25 th Street Sidewalks Project.		
25	Section 2. Funding for this project is from Infrastructure as Economic Development Accounting Unit		
26	108409 Activity S40G673.		
27	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or		
28	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or		
29	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution, which shall remain in full force and		
30	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of th		
31	resolution.		
32	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with		
33	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
