10	WHEREAS, Bids were solicited for improvements Bellemeade Drive Reconstruction, Project No. 06-
11	15-ST-259, Bid No. 627; and,
12	WHEREAS, Burkhalter Technologies, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
13	specifications.
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
15	OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:
16	Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Burkhalter
17	Technologies, Inc., for the Bellemeade Drive Reconstruction Project, in an amount not to exceed Two
18	Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Three and 40/100 Dollars (\$238,973.40), which
19	is the base bid amount of One Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand, One Hundred Forty-Four and 50/100
20	Dollars (\$199,144.50), plus 20% contingencies
21	Section 2. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating
22	Use Tax Funds and the 2018 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.
23	Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
24	word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
25	adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
26	effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
27	resolution.
28	Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
29	the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
