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WHEREAS, as set forth in Little Rock, Ark., Rev Code §§ 34-48 (1988), WHC Little Rock, LLC, doing business as zTrip and Yellow Cab respectively, has properly applied for approval for the issuance of two (2) Operator Permits at a cost of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) apiece and sixty (60) Taxicab Permits at a cost of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) each by the City; and,

WHEREAS, within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the application Fleet Services Director sent notice to applicant, each holder of a current operator permit, and all other interested persons in writing of the date of the hearing on the application, in accordance with A.C.A. §§ 14-57-307 and 14-57-308.; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Fleet Services Director has recommended the issuance of these sixty-two (62) permits be granted to WHC Little Rock, LLC for the 2026 term running from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, which will generate Four Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$4,600.00) in Permit Fees for the City.

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve the issuance of two (2) Operator Permits and sixty (60) Taxicab Permits to WHC Little Rock, LLC doing business as zTrip and Yellow Cab for the 2026 term running from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026.

Section 3. The Board expressly notes that prior to this public hearing, a written notice was sent to applicant, each holder of a current operator permit, and all other interested persons in writing of the date of the hearing.

1 **Section 4. *Severability.*** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
2 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
3 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
4 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
5 resolution.

6 **Section 5. *Repealer.*** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
7 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
