SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract extension with Our House to administer positive prevention programming for the City of Little Rock.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The amount is not to exceed \$100,000.00. Funds for this program are from the 2026 PIT Allocation. The cost of these programs shall not exceed \$100,000.00. The term for these contracts shall be no longer than one (1) year. Allowable expenditures on or after January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, shall be covered as expressed in the program provider's signed contract.

BACKGROUND	Bid No. 2671 was issued for Positive Prevention Programs for ages six (6) – twelve (12), and the organization listed below met the minimum score for funding consideration. Review panels consisting of City of Little Rock Staff met, reviewed applications, and recommended the organization listed below for Positive Prevention Programs (PPPs) during after-school/out-of-school time for Little Rock youth aged six (6) – twelve (12). The Commission on Children, Youth, and Families met on December 4, 2024, and voted to

Based on adequate performance and availability of funds, the Commission on Children, Youth and Families endorsed the organization for a one (1) year contract extension at its meeting on November 5, 2025.
