SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution authorizing the City Manager, or his designated representative, to apply for and if received, execute agreements with the Arkansas Department of Transportation for a Surface Transportation Project Grant to fund improvements to Bowman Road from Kanis Road south to Cherry Laurel Drive.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>The maximum grant amount is expected to be \$2,000,000, with an estimated City share of \$500,000.00. Funding for this project will be from an Arkansas Department of Transportation TAP Grant and a match from the Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax and the Capital Improvement Bonds for Streets and Drainage.</p>	
RECOMMENDATION	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
BACKGROUND	<p>Resolution No. 14,803 authorized a project to design these improvements and acquire right-of-way for a future construction project. These funds will assist with needed construction funding. The project will provide for full arterial intersection improvements at Kanis Road with a five (5)-lane arterial cross section to the south.</p>
