<p style="text-align: right;"><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Escamilla Excavating, LLC, for the Madison Valley Drainage Improvement Project, Bid No. 1720.</p> <p>The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$218,237.40, which is the base bid amount of \$152,952.00, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the Limited Tax General Obligation Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project will upgrade the existing drainage structures on Hanna Lane in the Madison Valley Subdivision to reduce flooding. Also included in the award at the request of adjacent landowners and the Board, is construction of an earthen berm to prevent run-off during high storm flow events in the western drainage from entering the eastern drainage system along Madison Valley and Hannah Lane. Escamilla Excavation, LLC,, was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of three (3) bids received for the project.</p>
