Currently the City doesn't have a Code for new construction of swimming pools and spas. Adoption of this Code would provide a guideline for construction of new pool and spa installations.</p> <p>None.</p> <p>Approval of the ordinance.</p> <p>There have been numerous Code hearings and research performed by the International Code Council before the general public, Code Officials, and professionals prior to development. The Code has been open to the public at the City Clerk's Office per Arkansas State Statute. In addition, notices were sent to various construction organizations.</p> <p>Adoption of this code would protect the public health, safety and welfare of citizens. This would help to alert home owners when adults or children access pool and spa areas utilizing alarms, safety gates, fences, locks, etc. This Code will address all construction and related requirements for Electrical, Plumbing and Mechanical Codes for new pool and spa installations.</p>
