

BACKGROUND

The Oakland Mausoleum, located in the sixty-two (62)-acre Oakland & Fraternal Historic Cemetery Park, was built nearly 100 years ago and is in need of some stabilization and restoration work. The Oakland & Fraternal Historic Cemetery Park Board engaged an architect familiar with restoration of historic properties, Tommy Jameson, to assess the restoration needs of the mausoleum. He devised a plan with technical specifications that formed the basis for the Request for Proposals. V.R. Smith & Sons, Inc., was the low bidder among the qualified bidders.
