

1 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into contracts for services that are in a form
2 acceptable to the City Attorney; further, nothing in this resolution prevents the City from being able to offer
3 similar services to any vendor during 2025 if, in its sole discretion, it decides to do so.

4 **Section 5. *Severability.*** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word
5 of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication
6 shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the
7 portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

8 **Section 6. *Repealer.*** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
9 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
