SYNOPSIS	The Five-Year Consolidated Plan outlines the goals and	
	objectives for housing and community development activities during the 2021-2025 program years. The Annual Action Plan delineates the uses of the CDBG, HOME, and HOPWA entitlements for the 2022 Program Year. This Board action approves the submission of the Amended Consolidated Plan and Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.	
FISCAL IMPACT	The City's CDBG, HOME and HOPWA entitlements, reallocated funds, along with projected program income for the 2022 Program Year totaled \$3,951,334.77. On December 21, 2021, the 2022 projected sources and uses of funds were approved at the Board Meeting (Resolution No. 15,599) and the amended 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan (Resolution 15,600). On June 7, 2022, the amended sources and uses (Resolution No. 15,703) were approved.

## BACKGROUND

The Amended 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2022 Annual Action Plan are submitted in accordance with requirements of the Title I of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990.

It is also consistent with the City's adopted Citizen Participation Plan. The Consolidated Planning Committee recommended the inclusion of activities Facility-Based Housing/Capital Development and Homebuyer Assistance to the 2021-2025 Consolidated Plan and 2022 Annual Action Plan as well as the amended sources and uses of the City's 2022 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds, Home Investment Partnerships Program, and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS.
