



1       **Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a one (1)-year agreement with the  
2 Downtown Little Rock Partnership, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand  
3 Dollars (\$195,000.00), for the provision of services to the City including, but not limited to, enhancing  
4 the overall Downtown Little Rock experience through Main Street revitalization, exploring and imple-  
5 menting creative ideas for spaces in the downtown area, overseeing lights and other decorations on Main  
6 Street, coordinating special events and providing Downtown Ambassadors.

7       **Section 2.** Funds for this Agreement will come from Account No. 100000-66110.

8       **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
9 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
10 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and  
11 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
12 resolution.

13       **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent  
14 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
