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WHEREAS, it has been deemed appropriate and necessary to analyze and design drainage channel improvements near 15808 Taylor Loop Road to address stream bank erosion and damage to private property; and,

WHEREAS, responses to an Invitation to Bid (“ITB”) Bid No. 3015 for Taylor Loop 15808 Drainage was received by the City of Little Rock on March 11, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, this contract shall be in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$477,570.00), which is the base bid amount of Three Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$397,975.00) plus a twenty percent (20%) contingency.

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the Taylor Loop 15808 Drainage project with Curtis Construction, Inc., in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Dollars, (\$477,570.00), which is the base bid amount of Three Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$397,975.00) plus a twenty percent (20%) contingency.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or

1 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
2 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
3 resolution.

4 **Section 4. *Repealer.*** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
5 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
