SYNOPSIS	Authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with KForce Government Solutions for the purchase of one (1) Trauma FX Whole Body Trauma Simulator for the Little Rock Fire Department, the Little Rock Police Department and Metropolitan Emergency Medical Services.
FISCAL IMPACT	The Emergency Management Division was awarded a grant through the Federal Department of Homeland Security for this purchase. The total cost, which is \$85,990.00, is 100% by the grant and will be paid from Account No. 270129-G030332.
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.
BACKGROUND	Since September 11, 2001, the City has become eligible for several emergency service equipment grants. These purchases are eligible items from those grants. This Trauma Simulator will assist First Responders throughout the City with a ruggedized lifelike experience for the best medical intervention training for a mass casualty event. This purchase is in accordance with Formal City Bid No. 18106, and KForce Government Solutions was the lowest responsible bidder.
