13	Million, Eight Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Nine Dollars (\$2,895,809.00) is available.		
14	including Three Hundred Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Eight and 17/100 Dollars (\$306,908.17) in 2020		
15	Program Income; and Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) in reallocated funds; and,		
16	WHEREAS, the proposed uses of the City's 2021 Entitlement Funds were developed with extensive		
17	citizen participation, including five (5) virtual meetings throughout the City and a seventeen (17)-member		
18	Consolidated Planning Committee; and prior to this public hearing, the Consolidated Planning Committee		
19	developed a slate of projects to recommend for Board approval so that the public hearing will give citizens		
20	an additional opportunity to review and comment on the proposed uses of the 2021 CDBG, HOME and		
21	HOPWA Funding; and,		
22	WHEREAS, the Consolidated Planning Committee will submit an allocation of funds as its		
23	recommendation to the Board.		
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY
