SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with NSC, Inc., to construct the Boyle Park Historic Pavilion No. 1 – Flagstone Remodel.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Amount for Construction Services is not to exceed a total project budget of \$113,622.30, which is the base bid amount of \$98,802.00, plus 15% contingencies. The City has obtained a grant for \$56,667.00 from the Recreation and Trails Program sponsored by the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program. Matching funds in the amount of \$28,333.00 will be provided, with \$20,000 from Grant Match Fund Account No. 108129-S10G042. The remaining funds in the amount of \$36,955.30 will be provided by Parks Development Funds, Account No.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The project will renovate the existing flagstone patio and walks located at Pavilion #1 in Boyle Park which are in need of major repairs due to age and improvements for ADA. The City held a Public Bid No.843 and two (2) vendors submitted bids for this work. The acceptable lowest bid was received from NSC, Inc., and staff has reviewed the bid and determined it to be responsible and recommends entering into contract with the bidder.
