SYNOPSIS	A resolution to authorize the City Manager to award a contract with Crafton, Tull & Associates, Inc., for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for Fourche Dam Pike and Pratt Remmel Road improvements.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Funding for the contract will be from Economic Development Agency, Delta Regional Authority with local match funds from Pulaski County and City of Little Rock.	
RECOMMENDATION	Approval of the resolution.	
BACKGROUND	The project includes the widening of Fourche Dam Pike from Interstate 440 to south of Frazier Pike, including the installation of signalized intersection at Lindsay Road and Frazier Pike and signal improvements at the intersection of Interstate 440 and Lindsay Road. In addition, the project includes the extension of Pratt Remmel Road to Frazier Pike and the widening of Frazier Pike from west of Apple Drive to east of Zeuber Road. The project will improve traffic flow and capacity in the Little Rock Port area. Crafton, Tull and Associates, Inc., was selected through a Statements of Qualifications process to provide design work for these projects.
