SYNOPSIS	To modify the current Cisco WebEx Contract, increasing the number of licenses from forty-five (45) to seventy-five (75), accommodating more remote workers. Upgrade to Cisco Event Center (Flex) in order to secure access and facilitate official City meetings, due to the Covid-19 Pandemic.	
FISCAL IMPACT	Funding for the total contract amount of Sixty-Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$69,930.00), plus applicable taxes and fees, is available as follows: the additional contract cost of Twenty-Six Thousand, Four Hundred Fifty-Four and 40/100 Dollars (\$26,454.40) for additional licenses and upgrades, plus applicable taxes and fees, is available from Covid-19 Funds in Account No. 108129-S10G044, and the remaining balance, plus applicable taxes and fees, is available in the Information Technology Department's Networking Re-Occurring Maintenance Account No. 103030-61350, which will be disbursed annually. Additional features and users may be added over the life of this contract with City Manager approval.

## BACKGROUND

The CISCO WebEx contract was renewed on July 24, 2019, for three (3) years. Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and the increase in remote workers, it is necessary to increase the number of license for end users and to upgrade to the Flex system which allows more secure control access and facilitation of remote meetings.
